Future Foundations was set up to due to the high prevalence of illiteracy among young people in Kenya who cannot go to secondary school or college because of poverty. In Kenya, only primary education is free meaning that many children never get to secondary school and are likely to drop out as they cannot see a future in their education. Future Foundations raise money through donations and fundraising events in order to pay secondary school fees and college fees for young people and give them the best possible chance of a successful future.



WHO WE ARE

Joseph Lewa grew up in Sabaki, Kenya and is the first person from his village to go to university. This was due to his uncle sponsoring him to go to secondary school. Joseph had to work at nights, weekends and holidays to get pocket money and also paid some of the school fees as well as to provide for his 6 younger siblings and mum, as his dad passed away in 2002 when he was just 16 years old.

In 2010, Vicki Samuels, Sam Samuels and Sharon Mackenzie visited Rainbow Community Care Orphanage in Kenya where Joseph was working. Vicki & Sam decided to sponsor him to go to Mount Kenya University. In 2012, Joseph graduated with a Diploma in Social Work & Community Development. Joseph now lives in Isle of Skye with his wife Sharon (who he met at Rainbow) and their two daughters Anna & Faith. He works as a Programme Facilitator at Columba 1400, a project which supports young people from disadvantaged backgrounds.

Sharon is originally from Skye and works as a social worker for NHS Highland. Joseph knows that without the support and faith of his uncle, and Vicki/Sam that his life (and his siblings lives) would be very different. Future Foundations was started in April 2013 by Sharon and Joseph to support the young people in Joseph's home town in Sabaki of Kenya.

WHAT WE DO

Future Foundations provides financial support to students in Kenya to attend further education. Without this support many young people in Kenya would not be able to attend higher education as the costs must be paid directly by the families. Future Foundations allows young people from poorer backgrounds an equal opportunity to make the most of their potential.

By providing financial support, our students then go on to attain higher education qualifications and better employment prospects. Once employed our students can then provide better financial support to their families.



Future Foundations run regular fundraising activities and events throughout the year to raise funds to support young people in Kenya from poorer backgrounds into further education.



Future Foundations provide financial assistance to young people in Kenya in order to further their education and career prospects. In doing this they can not only provide a better life for themselves but also their families.



HOW YOU CAN HELP

Future Foundations was set up to due to the high prevalence of illiteracy among young people in Kenya who cannot go to secondary school or college because of poverty. Many of these young people face other difficulties such as lack of basic needs, high rates of sexual abuse, orphaned due to HIV/AIDS related deaths, youth crime, gangs, drug abuse, prostitution and unemployment problems.

In Kenya, only primary education is free meaning that many children never get to secondary school and are likely to drop out of primary as they cannot see a future in their education. One years secondary school student fee for one young person is just £200 and a years college fee is £300.

By supporting Future Foundations you will allow us to expand our support to young people in Kenya by:



Paying student Secondary and College fees.



Financial support for Educational materials such as books, pens and uniforms.



Allow Future Foundations to run workshops for young people ranging from drug awareness courses to how to open a bank account.



All donations go directly to support young people into further education.


